Major David and Kathy Taylor say farewell after 19 years of Church leadership at the Wood Green Salvation Army. David has been passionately committed to the vision of Church unity in Haringey - through Pray Haringey, as a Bor-

ough Dean and on the Faith Forum. Kathy's major focus, besides unity, has been community facing projects and relationships, both from the Salvation Army Centre and locally, including being a stake holder in the Noel Park Children's Centre. David is going to teach at the Salvation Army's College in south London and Kathy will help direct and support community services from the Salvation Army's headquarters in the Elephant & Castle area. They will however, thankfully, continue to live locally in Palmers Green.

Rev. Andrew Dart has been in Muswell Hill for 5 years serving both as minister at Muswell Hill Methodist Church and as the Superintendent Minister of the New River Methodist Circuit (an area covering Haringey and beyond). He has also been a Police Chaplain and an honorary chaplain of two Methodist Homes in Muswell Hill. Andrew leaves at the end of July to take up a new post as Superintendent Minister of the Brixton and Streatham circuit.



Pastor Brendan Munro is returning for a second spell as the minister of The Gospel Centre in Hornsey. He pastored the church from 1989 to 2005, then stepped down to to serve the growing unity in Haringey, helping to network churches and encourage cross-church community facing projects.

He has served as a Borough Dean and Police Chaplain and will remain committed to the vision of unity and of course Pray Haringey.



Prayer Relay in Haringey

The 70-day More Than Gold Prayer Relay, which has mirrored the dates and route of the official Olympic Torch Relay, will arrive on Tottenham Green in Haringey at **12.30 pm on Wednesday July 25th.**

While the Olympic Torch heads for Alexandra Palace on the same date, Churches in Haringey are invited to gather on Tottenham Green (outside the Town Hall) to pray for our communities, the Games and the nations.

On the following day, Thursday July 26th, a number of us from Haringey will be joining others for a special hand-over of the prayer relay at Westminster. We'll be meeting at Marsham Street at 12.30, prayer walking to Westminster and participating in a specially organised prayer meeting for our MP's, the Games and our nation.

Choices Haringey are seeking to expand their work with women who are experiencing a crisis pregnancy or suffering the after effects of an abortion. We need more volunteers. Can you help us? Have you thought of volunteering or would you be prepared to become a trustee?

Did you know that:

1. Haringey spent the least per head on sexual health services in 2009?
2. The teenage pregnancy rate in Haringey was the highest in England in 2010?
3. There is a stark difference in sexual health statistics across the borough? There is a massive need in the east of the borough. Only 5 of Haringey's wards have teenage pregnancy rates lower than the national average and they are all in the west of the borough.
4. Haringey is the 4th most deprived borough in London?

We need advisors who can meet with clients and volunteers to help with administration and fundraising. We also need trustees who are experienced in financial matters, involved in NHS or have other skills to offer.

We are running a training program for new volunteers and trustees in the Autumn 2012. This training will give you information about the work we do and help you to talk empathetically and knowledgeably to our clients as appropriate. These Boots Are Made for Praying!!

In another major Prayer Initiative for London many hundreds of Christians from churches across the capital will be doing a 120 mile prayer walk over six days around the borders of the city, encompassing all 33 London boroughs. **“Walk the Walls”** starts at Harold Hill on Sunday 21st July at 8.30am and finishes at 7.30pm on Thursday July 26th at The River Christian Centre, Canning Town. People can join in for the whole week, a leg of the journey, and/or any of the lunchtime & evening celebrations. There are two teams walking each day. **The Power Team** - who will walk every mile each day, and **The Presence Team** - who will walk at a more leisurely pace, stopping to pray at different locations along, and near the route. If you can't make the whole 6 days then why not join for a day or two. The last night will be the culmination of the week and a great chance to pray over east London, the night before the Olympics begin. In regards to the first night, Sublime are partnering with the

Global Day of Prayer and Urban Saints in holding a prayer event at Marsham Street, Westminster. This is part of the build up to the national prayer and worship at Wembley Stadium, A big part of the vision for Wembley is that we release young people to be a catalyst for uniting and mobilising the church for prayer and transformation as we take the good news of the Gospel onto the streets in 2013 and 2014.
